

BASC Foreign Born Birth Certificate Requirement

As a parent of a foreign born player, US Soccer and FIFA require you to complete additional forms and submit supporting documentation for your child to play soccer in the USA. This is not a rule set by Broken Arrow Soccer Club. We are here to help you understand the process the best we can, but we are not able to approve your child. This process needs to be started within 7 days of your player's registration.

This requirement applies to your player regardless of their citizenship status. If your player was adopted from a foreign country, born on a foreign US military base, or born in a foreign country, US Soccer and FIFA require you to complete this process.

Age 10-17, U.S. Citizen	Prior to 10	First Registration	Minors Process
Age 10-17, Non-U.S. Citizen	Prior to 10	Minors Process	Minors Process
Age 18+	Prior to 10	First Registration	ITC Request
